What is Human Trafficking?

Human trafficking is a severe violation of human rights.

It is the illegal sale of a human being for forced labor or sexual exploitation.

A trafficked human being is treated as an **object** – sold over and over again to make money.

It is estimated that **27**% of all trafficked victims in the world today are **children.** The average age of a child victim, especially for forced labor or sexual exploitation, **is less than 14 years!**

Human trafficking is a crime against the dignity and integrity of an individual. It is **"modern-day** slavery".

It is the **3rd most profitable** and fastest growing criminal activity in the world, after arms and drugs.

The profits made from human trafficking is about **\$32 billion** per year – equivalent to the profits of Apple and McDonald's combined!

This is a problem that exists in or affects **all countries** in the world. The youth can be victims of different types of trafficking from an early age, such as:

- Forced labor
- Sexual exploitation
- In armed forces
- In drug trades
- Begging
- Forced marriages

They have always been an important component of our activities since the creation of our association, End Human Trafficking Now (EHTN), in 2006.

Today's youth are activists and promoters of change!

We have integrated a young people's section in all our events and will continue to do so in the future.

This is not only a twoway learning experience but also an opportunity to hear what young people have to say, and take **their thoughts and concerns** on board.
